In pursuance of guidelines No. P.33 (2)Home/Gr.9/2019 dated March 22, 2020 issued by Government of Rajasthan the company was completely lockdown & manufacturing activities of the company were stopped from March 23, 2020, followed by the guidelines of Government of India issued against the spread of CoVID-19 on March 24, 2020.

Further, according to the guidelines No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated May 17, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India and guidelines No. F.33 (2)Home/Gr.9/2019 dated May 18, 2020 issued by the Government of Rajasthan – Home Department related to CoVID-19, the company has re-started its operations and accordingly workmen and staff have come back to join their duties with full zeal and enthusiasm to face the oncoming challenges with a completely positive frame of mind-set.

All the plants/offices are intact with prevention systems in place and all associates have ben aptly trained to prevent this virus from spreading. The company has also equipped all locations with necessary sanitising machines, sanitising stations, touch-less taps, gloves, masks, face shields etc.

Moving forward, the company is also getting all the plants/offices audited by external agencies to verify the measures for their effectiveness towards prevention of this disease.

Proper steps have been implemented to ensure smooth functioning of operations and has assessed to the fair extent, the impact of ability to service debt and other financing arrangements, capital and financial resources, assets, internal financial reporting and control and supply chain and found that these will not be adversely impacted, significantly.





After lockdown our marketing team procured orders worth Rs. 50 Crores. Our newly added segment of manufacturing cables for RDSO (Railways) has also been lucky to have new orders. Henceforth, the company is focusing more on International business with Advances technology Cables & Conductors for which various International agency approvals are under process. We are envisaging a serious boost in this particular segment in the coming times.

Existing contracts/agreements where non-fulfillment of the obligations by any party will not have significant impact on the business of the company.

The company is assessing the future impact of CoVID-19 on its operations, profitability liquidity position, and demand for its products/services. The company will update on these issues by the time of declaration of the financial results for the half year and financial year ended March 31, 2020.
