# Long jumper Shaili Singh ready to soar on world stage

Buoyed by Neeraj Chopra's success, 17-year-old will look to extend the celebratory mood at her first international event in Nairobi

LONG JUMPER Shaili Singh watched the men's javelin throw final at the Tokyo Olympics on her phone. The 17-year-old was glued to the screen as Neeraj Chopra ended India's athletics medal drought. Keeping track of the Summer Games for the first time in her life, just a week before she was to travel for the World U20 Athletics Championships, the historic gold has spurred hope in the long jumper to dream big too.

As the country is reveling in this post-Olympic celebration, she's hoping to prolong the festivities by capturing a medal at the Championships in Nairobi. Stars have emerged at the world event - Chopra finished atop the podium in 2016 and quarter-miler Hima Das was the first Indian to win a gold medal on track two years later. "I did not follow the Rio Olympics. I wasn't really into athletics five years ago," she says. "This time I watched with full josh. When Neeraj won the gold, I was dancing with the other athletes I share a place with. Seeing an Indian athlete win such a big medal was inspirational."

The teenager from Jhansi moved to Bangalore three-and-a-half years ago to train with Robert Bobby George. Robert coached his wife Anju when she won a bronze medal at the 2003 World Championships - a year before Shaili was born. Now that she's ready to compete at her first ever international tournament, she's been googling 'weather in Nairobi,' and searching for pictures of the Kasarani Stadium in the Kenyan capital.

"The weather is nice (19 degree Celsius). It will be like Bangalore in December or January. I am targeting a distance which (Robert) sir has given me, which is 6.60 metres. Sir says that I am in that range. If I achieve my target, even if there is no medal, it is okay," she says self-effacingly.

Modesty aside, she is one of the favourites. On the provisional entry list for the long jump, she is the fifth-best jumper.

Her 'linear' and 'steady' improvement makes Robert confident of Shaili not being overawed by the magnitude of the competition. Breaking two age-group records in one competition in June was a special effort, the

experienced coach says.

Before travelling for the National Inter-State Athletics Championship in Patiala in June, Shaili had not competed in nearly two years because of Covid-19 restrictions. She could not train on a synthetic track because stadia were closed. On her return, Shaili didn't hold back. She broke the National Youth record before setting a new national U20 mark, a new personal best of 6.48 metres. "That jump in Patiala... She was about 15 centimetres behind the board. She is in the 6.50-plus club right now," Robert says.

"It is not going to be easy. I am sure if she improves on her personal best she will be in the medal bracket. Even with 6.48m she is capable of winning a medal as it is better than the silver medalist from the last U20 World Championships (in 2018) and just three centimetres less than the gold medalist."

The coach has spoken earlier about Shaili being destined to break Anju's long-standing national record of 6.83 metres. The speed on the runway, fast twitch muscles, ability to grasp technique and clarity of thought is what sets her apart from the former jumper.

An athletic body and a mind like a sponge makes her a pleasure to coach, says Anju. "For someone who is just 17, she is a quick learner which is needed in technical events. She has that spark. What we tell her, she is ready to absorb without any hesitation. We are protecting her like an egg shell. We are not giving her full-swing training, it is very precise training for her. Lucky thing is her muscles are very strong. Her genes are different and she has fast twitch muscles. That is a big advantage," Anju elaborates.

An X-factor is the natural speed she has in the run-up to help her cover the distance, like an aeroplane accelerating before take-off. "Speed is an advantage as it came to her naturally. I had to teach her the right-running skills. Power can be developed but in long jump speed is a must. Her joints and muscles are still developing. She has to be on the field for more than a decade. But in the process, I have to ensure that she develops no muscle imbalance," Robert says.

The association between the coach and the long jumper began nearly four years ago. Robert saw her jumping at the junior national championships in Manglagiri, Vijayawada. Shaili finished fifth but the coach didn't go by just the result. He made a call to her mother Vinita, a tailor by profession. Eventually she agreed to send her daughter to Bangalore. Vinita has stopped tailoring because of a constant migraine, Shaili says. Her mother follows her competitions keenly and she is the first person Shaili gives result updates to.

"Mummy is very happy. She is a little worried because this is my first competition abroad," Shaili says. "But she always encourages me. Mummy has said don't worry, 'ache se, shanti se kama'. Then it will work."

# Anu Kumar back on track after injury, personal loss

Gold at the 2018 junior Asian Athletics Championships was supposed to come with the promise of better tidings. That's what 800m specialist Anu Kumar hoped for. With the win he harboured dreams of making it big on the circuit, but the 18-year-old's luck took a sudden dive. A shattered ankle, a harsh lockdown, and his father's demise followed the on-track success.

Now he will compete at his first international competition since winning the continental title, when he takes to the track at the U20 World Athletics Championships in Nairobi. It'll be a hard task for the youngster to follow in the footsteps of former world U20 gold medal winners Neeraj Chopra (2016) and Hima Das (2018), but his aim is to honour his father's memory. His father, Mahipal Singh used to deliver gas cylinders in Haridwar till he lost his job during the pandemic-forced lockdown last year, and passed away in December. "My father always wanted me to do well in athletics. I thought when I reach New Delhi today, I will call him once. I almost forgot for a second that he's no more," Anu says, still on the way to the capital from his base in Patiala. "Then it hit me. I don't know whom I will share my stories with now. I am still lost."

The athletics squad is scheduled to leave on Saturday night for the world event in Nairobi. After his 2018 Asian triumph, expectations from Anu began to soar. He was the favourite to seal the berth for the 2018 Youth Olympics but was defeated by Sree Kiran Nandakumar in the Asian area qualification held in Bangkok after an ankle niggles kept him down. "The pain was unbearable so I had to undergo an MRI to find the cause. There was some trouble with the cartilage in my ankle. It was due to the workload. The injury kept me away from any physically strenuous activity for a long time," the World School Games silver medalist says.

The road to recovery was made tougher after the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic due to a lack of competition. The Indian athletics circuit had come to a standstill until March 2021 when the Federation Cup in Patiala was organised. Despite all these setbacks, Anu kept training with his coach in the hills of Pauri Garhwal. And just when he had found his rhythm and was clocking decent timings, came the heart-breaking news of his father's death.

"My recovery was complete and I was do-

ing really well. I received a call at 5:00 AM and I could not process what had happened. I still can't. He was my biggest supporter and best friend. I shared every minute detail of my sport and life with him. It was his dream to see me run," says the teenager.

Anu was so taken aback by this loss that he decided to hang his spikes. He didn't see any purpose in continuing in the sport with his biggest supporter not being by his side. For the next three months, let alone training, Anu did not even step out of the house. It was then that Anu's brother-in-law, who had inspired him to take up athletics in the first place, decided he had to step in.

"My brother-in-law told me I can't be sitting and weeping like this and that I have to honour my dad's memory and desires by continuing to run. My dad's death had broken me, but I had to really push myself (to get back)," he recalls.

He may not be in the best shape at the moment, but he has a renewed vigour in his approach. He knows age is on his side, and there are plenty of competitions ahead where he can finish atop the podium. But Anu says there are some little joys that life has snatched away now, that even golds at international meets cannot compare to.

"My dad used to prepare the best fish curry in the world. Whenever I went home, he made it for me without fail," he says. "I know that I won't be able to have that meal again and I yearn for it. Medals toh aate rahenge, lekin phir se papa ke hath ka khana khane ka mauka nahi ayega (Medals will come and go but I know I will never be able to have a meal prepared by my father again)."

ब्रिक्स का खाद्य सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित करने के लिए कृषि-जैवविविधता भागीदारी पर जोर

नई दिल्ली। ब्रिक्स देशों ने खाद्य और पोषण सुरक्षा सुनिश्चित करने के लिए कृषि-जैव विविधता को मजबूत करने को आपसी घनिष्ठ संबंधों पर जोर दिया है। ब्राज़ील, रूस, भारत, चीन और दक्षिण अफ्रीका (ब्रिक्स) के शीर्ष कृषि अधिकारियों के प्रतिनिधित्व वाले कृषि कार्यकारी समूह में 12-13 अगस्त को इस विषय पर चर्चा की गई। एक आधिकारिक बयान में कहा गया कि समूह ने कृषि के क्षेत्र में सहयोग और अनुसंधान को मजबूत करने के लिए घनिष्ठ संबंधों के निर्माण पर जोर दिया। बैठक में समूह ने कहा कि संयुक्त राष्ट्र ने इस बात का उल्लेख किया है कि ब्रिक्स देश भूख और गरीबी को मिटाने के लिए 2030 सतत विकास लक्ष्यों के उद्देश्यों को प्राप्त करने में मदद करने के लिए अग्रणी भूमिका निभाने के लिए सहज से अच्छी स्थिति में हैं।

चीनी निर्यात 51.1 लाख टन तक पहुंचा, इंडोनेशिया को हुआ सबसे ज्यादा निर्यात : चीनी व्यापार संघ

नई दिल्ली। चीनी मिलों ने, सितंबर में समाप्त हो रहे विपणन वर्ष 2020-21 में अब तक 51.1 लाख टन चीनी का निर्यात किया है, जिसमें सबसे अधिक निर्यात इंडोनेशिया को किया गया है। उद्योग निकाय एआईएसटीए ने यह जानकारी दी है। एआईएसटीए ने कहा कि लगभग 2,02,521 टन चीनी लदान की प्रक्रिया में है। अतिरिक्त 6,78,237 टन चीनी बंदरगाह स्थित रिफाइनरियों को डिलीवरी के लिए रास्ते में है। अखिल भारतीय चीनी व्यापार संघ (एआईएसटीए) ने एक बयान में कहा कि चीनी मिलों ने इस साल जनवरी में खाद्य मंत्रालय द्वारा सौंपे गए पूरे 60 लाख टन चीनी कोटे का निर्यात अनुबंध किया है। इसके अलावा बिना सब्सिडी समर्थन के खुले सामान्य लाइसेंस के तहत अतिरिक्त 8,00,000 टन चीनी निर्यात का अनुबंध भी किया गया है। चीनी विपणन वर्ष अक्टूबर से सितंबर तक चलता है। एआईएसटीए के अनुसार, चीनी मिलों ने एक जनवरी से पांच अगस्त 2021 तक कुल 51.1 लाख टन चीनी का निर्यात किया है। किए गए कुल निर्यात में से, अब तक इंडोनेशिया को सबसे ज्यादा 16.9 लाख टन चीनी का निर्यात किया गया है, इसके बाद अफगानिस्तान को 6,23,967 टन, संयुक्त अरब अमीरात (यूएई) को 4,60,816 टन और श्रीलंका को 3,78,280 टन चीनी का निर्यात किया गया। एआईएसटीए ने कहा, कि हमें यह कहते हुए गर्व है कि निर्यात की गई या निर्यात की प्रि या के तहत आने वाले चीनी का मूल्य 2.5 अरब डॉलर या लगभग 18,600 करोड़ रुपये से अधिक है, जो विशेषकर महामारी से प्रभावित वर्ष में देश की निर्यात आय में योगदान देता है तथा किसानों को गल्ला मूल्य चुकाने के लिए चीनी मिलों के हाथ में नकदी का इजाफा करता है। उद्योग संगठन ने कहा है, 'वैश्विक बाजारों में बदलते राजनीतिक परिदृश्य के बीच, ईरान को चीनी निर्यात करने के लिए कोई तरीका निकालना होगा। इससे भारत को अपने बाजार का विस्तार करने में मदद मिलेगी। वर्तमान विपणन वर्ष समाप्त होने के साथ, एआईएसटीए ने कहा कि अगले वर्ष के लिए चीनी निर्यात नीति की समय पर घोषणा करने की तत्काल आवश्यकता है। इसमें कहा गया है कि ब्राजील में मौसम की समस्याओं के कारण अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजार में चीनी का भाव 10 जुलाई को 17.28 सेंट प्रति पाउंड से बढ़कर 11 अगस्त 2021 को 19.59 सेंट प्रति पाउंड हो गया है, जो लगभग 13.4 प्रतिशत की वृद्धि को दर्शाता है।
